

Bargain Box Grant Guidelines

1. Organizations requesting grant consideration must be a nonprofit with the ability to furnish a tax-exempt letter or other nonprofit status documentation.
2. Amount of Grant money available will be based on the prior year's profit. (Amount will be available mid January.)
3. Any organization with a staff member, volunteer, or director currently serving on the Bargain Box Advisory Board is ineligible from receiving funding from the Bargain BOX.
4. Grant money will be used to fund:
 - a) Projects that improve the quality of life for people in need.
 - b) Priority will be given to local projects, projects that have not previously received Bargain Box, children's programs, and organizations that stress “empowerment” of individuals/families.
 - c) Special projects (such as Crow Reservation, Montana project) will be reviewed by the Advisory Board and a determination made if funding is available.

Grant Timetable:

- Grant requests must be submitted for consideration by March 1st.
 - Grant Awards will be announced in June.
- If funding is available after June, grant applications will continue to be accepted.
